

This letter, with accompanying spreadsheet and pipe replacement project map are supporting documents for the Lead Service Line Replacement (LSLR) Section of the City of Sacramento (City) 2019 electronic Annual Report, previously submitted to your office on 6/17/2020. The City's LSLR project is part of the City's ongoing Accelerated Meter Project. The City will have completed replacement of all lines and fittings of unknown materials and/or lead by the end of June 2020. Lines and fittings replaced include 5,786 service lines of unknown material and 210 lead fittings (goosenecks, pigtails and corporation stops) - all in the East Sacramento area.
